**Public Hearing on Assessment of Cable License Applicants**

The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Princeton, Massachusetts has received amended cable license applications and proposals from Charter Communications Entertainment I, LLC and from Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC dated February 21, 2017. Pursuant to 207 CMR 3.03(4), the Board of Selectmen, as cable license Issuing Authority, shall hold a public hearing on March 13, 2017, 6:30 p.m. at the Thomas Prince School, 170 Sterling Street, Princeton, MA to assess the qualifications of the applicants, which shall include review of the amended license applications, the Issuing Authority Report on license specifications, oral testimony at the hearing and duly accepted hearing record information for consideration in connection with the awarding or denying license applications pursuant to 207 CMR 3.03 the federal Cable Act and applicable law. License applicants, residents and other interested persons shall have an opportunity to be heard.
