LICENSE FEES

Males/Females (not neutered or spayed) \$ 15.00/dog
Spayed or Neutered \$ 10.00/dog
Late fee (After the last business day in April) \$ 25.00/dog (In addition to license fee)
(Late fee excludes dogs that were less than 6 months prior to the last business day in April.)

New residents have 30 days to license. If your dog has a current license in another town in MA you can transfer that license (with proof) for a fee of \$2.00. Contact the Town Clerk for more information on transfer requirements.

Return this form with a stamped, self-addressed envelope, a check made payable to the Town of Princeton, and a copy of a current rabies certificate. A spay or neuter certificate (if applicable) is also required if that information is not included on the rabies certificate. Mail to: Princeton Town Clerk, 6 Town Hall Dr. Princeton, MA 01541.
