

**\* NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION \***  
**Regarding the Princeton Municipal Light Department  
and the Princeton Broadband Municipal Light Plant**

The **Princeton Municipal Light Department (“PMLD”)** has been providing electrical service to the businesses and residents of Princeton for over 100 years. **The mission** of the Princeton Municipal Light Department is to provide a safe, reliable, and economical source of electric power for our customers, to acknowledge and implement the need for renewable energy from within the diversity of available energy sources, and to enhance the benefits of municipal utility ownership for our customers.

The PMLD has its own elected Board of Commissioners, General Manager, and staff that operate autonomously from the Town of Princeton Selectmen, Town Administrator, and other boards and committees. The many phone calls, inquiries, and other contacts that we have had over the past several months at PMLD with residents of the Town of Princeton suggest that there is confusion regarding the relationship between the proposed fiber optic network in Princeton and PMLD. The purpose of this letter is to clarify any confusion.

*The **Princeton Broadband Municipal Light Plant (“PBMLP”)** also referred to as the “Broadband MLP” or simply the “MLP” was formed in recent years for the purpose of owning and operating a broadband fiber optic network within the Town of Princeton. The PBMLP has its own Board of Commissioners and Manager and has no connection whatsoever with PMLD. The current Board of Selectmen of the Town of Princeton are the Board of Commissioners for the PBMLP. Any and all decisions that are made concerning the PBMLP are made by that Board, not the PMLD Board.*

As a further note of clarification, PMLD is actively working at the request of and under contract with the PBMLP Board to “make-ready” the existing distribution system for the construction of a broadband fiber network. When this work is done, PMLD will not be involved with choosing, installing, operating or maintaining any fiber network system that may be built by the PBMLP or any other network provider in the future.
