To keep the most heavily traveled roads in Town in a good state thereby preventing costly damage to the base of these roads.

To insure that secondary roads are milled and reconstructed as needed in order to prevent cracking of the road surface, the development of pot holes and the management of water flows.

To begin to convert dirt and gravel roads to paved roads in order to reduce maintenance costs and upkeep.

To rebuild bridges and culverts as needed.

To apply for all available Federal and State grants in order to reduce the costs of repairing bridges, culverts and roads.
