It was learned that the current owners would be moving November 1st and they were rehoming the horses.

Lauren Stimson – 71 Gates Rd – Bldg Dept requested the board review the plans for the building addition permit submitted by the Stimson's. There is a kitchen indicated on the plan. Jim contacted Lauren and spoke with her about their proposed plans. They are moving their business that is currently located at 2 Mountain Rd. They have 3 employees and it is a kitchenette /break area for the employees. Jim stated that it does not meet the criteria for a commercial kitchen. No permits are required from the BOH in regards to their kitchenette. No design changes needed for the septic system.
