Since our last meeting, the following work has been completed:

• The force main has been installed

- During installation, the trench work was inspected by the board of health
- The effluent pump was installed in the garage
- The effluent pump was inspected by one the Town's plumbing inspectors
- The design engineer has submitted a septic system as-built plan
- The board of health has reviewed and approved the as-built plan
- The design engineer submitted the certificate of compliance formwork

Lar has inspected the site and the trench and conduit are exposed. Needs to spread loam. Mr Camp stated that it would be done mid July. He continues to make payments for court costs to the Town. Will report any updates.

Agricultural Regs: Still working on the draft. Lar will reach out to Ed Good for more input and report to board.

Well Regs: Lar will scan and distribute to board for review/comments.

Triple E: (JH) noted that the town does not spray although there is an increase in cases in central mass. The EAC is looking into this as well.

Covid Vaccination: (JH) noted that the CDC links regarding vaccinations for young children is up on their website.

Stop The Bleed: (JH) attended a training session on STB protocols. He rec'd a kit and would like to request that the Town receive more to have in the public buildings and school. (TL) will inquire.

Yaglou: Since our last meeting, an order to correct was issued. William Yaglou continues to keep the board updated on his progress. See below report from Mr. Yaglou....:

- Installed shutters in the attic crawl space window
- Removed a number of unregistered cars with the intent to remove the rest on Friday. (Note: we had to order new rims for the antique corvette before it can be moved.)
- Removed even more tires, recyclables, and debris
- In addition, we have raked up a lot of leaves near the southside of the property (where the wind blows them) in an effort to reduce the bug habitat near our next-door neighbor's property line.

Next week I hope to be able to recycle another load or two of scrap and remove more debris to the dump. The place looks a lot better, and we will continue to address your issues.
