Superintendent Report (see attached report for details)

- Restoration work at entrance to Woodlawn Cemetery still not begun. (B. Metcalf from Highway Department is supposed to investigate cost to pave.)
- Superintendent Rollins is looking for better coordination with Highway Department regarding assistance at burials. Bruce is preparing guidelines for the process involved with full and cremation burials, in part to clarify various responsibilities. Bruce and Chair Grettum are to investigate the situation and push for better compliance with expected help from HD.

Cemetery Site Visit Findings

Observations from cemetery site visits prior to meeting were discussed and cataloged.

Woodlawn Cemetery

- Driveway entrance still in need of improvement; replanting grass or paving over? Waiting for paving cost information.
- Stone wall area at entrance to 1986 section needs landscaping to complete project. Needs removal of remaining plants/rocks, fill with loam and replanting grass. Some new stones added to wall look inappropriate remove?
- Water pump needs priming.
- Remove 'ugly' bushes along roadway path in 1956 section.
- Place flowers in urns at driveway entrance; P. Constantino to obtain plants.

South Cemetery

- Broken guardrail and abandoned tractor trailer on Ball Hill Road side are perennial issues.
- Several broken/fallen monument stones.
- Bennet grave lot needs fill and reseeding.

- Members to individually visit remaining cemeteries for site review; bring observations to next meeting.
- Possible update on cemetery management software.
