Yesterday, Gov. Charlie Baker announced plans to change the distribution of COVID-19 vaccines in Massachusetts by shifting reliance to smaller local clinics and providing more doses to regional collaboratives and mobile operations. This plan includes closing 4 of 7 mass vaccination sites in June. Princeton residents are encouraged to call the Town of Princeton COVID Information and Vaccination Request line at 978-464-2114 to schedule vaccinations at the Rutland Regional Collaborative. Beginning late last week, masks are no longer required outdoors if you can maintain social distancing. However, we ask that residents wear masks at Town of Princeton events such as the Annual Town Meeting and the Town Election. This order also rescinded and/or relaxed several sector-specific guidelines.
