Gov. Baker announced the following dates regarding the reopening of Massachusetts:

- May 18, 2021 participants in youth sports will no longer have to wear facemasks during outdoor play.
- May 29, 2021 The Commonwealths current face covering order will be rescinded and replaced with an order consistent with new <u>CDC guidance</u>. Additionally, the gathering, capacity, and all COVID-19 related industry restrictions will be lifted.
- June 15, 2021 State of Emergency for Commonwealth of Massachusetts ends.
