The Town of Princeton Selectboard voted to require masks in public spaces in town buildings with masks and distancing at public meetings with remote participation available effective Monday, Aug. 16, 2021. Medical and age exemptions may apply.

The MA Dept of Public Health is currently surveying all Local Boards of Health to determine interest and their ability to hold clinics for the general population when the Covid 19 booster is available. Princeton has submitted our response and is waiting for guidance based on the results of this survey.

Immunocompromised individuals are eligible for a COVID 19 Booster. The booster must be administered at least 8 months after your initial vaccination. Check with your healthcare provider to confirm if you qualify. Please visit <https://vaxfinder.mass.gov/> to locate vaccination locations.
