- Public comment period: no public comments

- Rotate role of secretary?
 - o Will see if a new member is interested
 - o For now MK will continue in the role
 - o At 6 month mark, we may start to rotate
- Resident Survey summary report:
 - o PM put together a qualitative report of the survey
 - o **ACTION ITEM**: Deadline for looking at Phoebe's report by end of this week (Sunday night) to see if anything jumps out for highlighting, noting of themes
 - Reply all
- Sharing Survey Results: not to present conclusions/recommendations, but simply share results of the survey
 - o w/ Board of Selectmen (BOS) on March 5th
 - need to ask at that meeting what the exact term of EAC is (to June or September?)
 - Provide them with hard copies of PM's reports
 - o w/ PMLD and try to present at their next meeting after the 3/5 meeting
 - **ACTION ITEM**: CG will find out when next meeting is after 3/5 and try to get on their agenda
 - o **Action Item:** CBH will put a notice in town news regarding meetings at BOS and PMLD survey presentation
 - CBH moved; MK seconded; 5-0
 - o **Action Item:** CG will check in with Nina to see if she can extend invitation to other committees to the 3/5 (or next scheduled) BOS meeting to hear EAC presentation on the survey
- Massachusetts Green Communities
 - o Update that Green Communities confirmed Princeton has one investorowned utility customer, which is one way to meet a key eligibility requirements of becoming a Green Community
 - o Should we have MA Green Communities present to BOS?
 - Debate about whether we should have that presentation now or later on when EAC recommendations more developed

- ACTION ITEM: CG will check in with Green Communities contact (Kelly Brown) to get her thoughts on best timing to present to BOS
- New Member: Chris Samoiloff
 - o CG moved; PG seconded; approved 5-0
- Energy Advocacy Through Massachusetts Climate Action Network (MCAN)
 - o MCAN has asked whether EAC would like to form a chapter
 - Would mean becoming part of a network with other towns, get advice/training
 - Examples of what chapters are doing: greenhouse gas inventories; speakers series; etc.
 - o Committee agreed that this would not be appropriate for EAC, more appropriate for individuals in individual capacities
- Wachusett Meadow Sanctuary Sheep Fest (April 28th at 1:00pm) EAC presence?
 - o Sanctuary would be interested in having EAC at fest
 - o We could perhaps have an information sheet on gardening, lawn care, pesticides, etc.
 - o Not clear whether this falls within our town warrant mission
 - ACTION ITEM: CG will check in w/ BOS at next meeting as to whether they are comfortable with EAC doing outreach/info sharing
 - o PG moved to approve this, pending BOS approval, MK seconded
 - 5-0 approval
- EAP Research and inquiry; status update, outlines
 - o Important for any recommendations contained in final document:
 - What are costs?
 - Where to get funding?
 - What are benefits?
- Work in groups?
 - o Members working in specific topic areas will inform other members which sections they are working on
