Ebenezer Parker Jr. took up this place in 1818 and gave land and bldgs. for the Town of Princeton
Poor Farm 1837

Amos Parker, son, managed it 1842 - 1847

moved to Worcester 1874

Various occupants:

J. Warren Kendall (Tenney's grandfather managed c. late 1800's)

Town Farm given up 1900 - 1903

Thurston and E.R. Buck 1904 - 1925 - 1928

Joseph Bonukevich bot from T. Buck estate c. 1930

Gurnsey and Sadie M. Clough

Albert Calcia bot. 1965

Albert and Josephine Calcia (1994, 1998 street lists)

Josephine (and sons (?) Joseph and Allen Calcia (2005, 2006 street lists)
