- Discussion of lights for East Princeton. Gregory Oswitt from Lynch Co. sent the PHC specifications for the three light options for East Princeton.
 - In attendance, Brian Allen, Princeton Municipal Light Department (PMLD) representative
 - Recommends purchasing additional stations and globes in case one breaks
 - How many lights are going in? 98? What is the price per unit?
 - Town needs to be sure the maintenance of the lights is in the town budget moving forward because all maintenance will require a police detail
 - Might be worth looking into replacing the 8 lights in the town center – might be able to get a better price if purchasing in bulk. PMLD would install these.
 - PHC likes the light design, recommends a warm light to resemble period 19th century gas lighting
 - PHC will ask for a sample with warm light
 - Can you replace the light bulb or do you need to replace the entire fixture? How much do they cost?
 - Shading or shroud for lights –How many we will need shrouded?
 - Recommend a ball finial and Frosted Hurricane Chimney (FHC)
