


TRAILS AROUND PRINCETON



Princeton Land Trust (PLT) Gregory-Alexander Trails



These trails are managed by the Princeton Land Trust President@PrincetonLandTrust.net

Trails lead up (80 ft elevation gain) to Prospect Street and the Princeton town center. The route goes through a small wetland and then climbs through open forest. A spur trail to the north leads to Gregory Spring, which was the original water source for the town center.
