Director Updates

- Update on programs. P&R receive \$10.00 per participant in all programs.
- P&R commission formally approved the following policy regarding instructors and programs:
 - Instructors are paid at end of session
 - Class registration closes 48 hours before class begins at any after-school activities @TPS
 - No registration accepted after a class begins
 - Instructors will be allowed to advertise their own class with flyers or social media only with P&R approval
 - All instructors are to notify families, P&R, TPS of any changes to a class, for example sickness, inclement weather, etc.
 - All make up days are to be scheduled with P&R before announced
 - All instructors must provide a W9, CORI w/ license and insurance (when applicable)
- Field agreement update
 - Separate baseball/softball field agreements from soccer field agreements
 - Offer TPS upper field at a reduced rate (field not being maintained by P&R)
 - Definition of a Princeton team is 51% of participants are residents of Princeton.
