Director Updates – Hollie

- There is some standing water on the soccer fields. DPW will need to add fill to these areas.
- Field 3 nets were replaced last year, consider replacing nets and goals for both field 1 & 2 next year.
- Committee discussed types of playground equipment to purchase and where at Krashes to locate the play structure. Question - where is the irrigation lines and septic located at Krashes. Maybe an “As Build” plan is at town hall?
- Heritage Landscaping quote to bring Babe Ruth field back is \$5,100. We would make this a multiuse field. Softball and Baseball. The in-field grass would need to be removed. The pitcher’s mound would be mobile.
- The slide area located at Sawyer field needs bark mulch. Hollie will contact DPW.

Financials

- Field house freezer needed additional repair - \$350.00. It has been 2 weeks without any issue after repair.
- Hollie purchased the following items: 8 new poles for soccer fields, 3 basketballs & table-top scoreboard for basketball court.

New Business

- Committee unanimously accept motion to make Emily full P&R member. Alternate member position is now open.
- Committee discussed possible movie night at Krashes. Cost to rent movie equipment - projector and screen would be \$800.00. This would probably be too expensive since we won’t be generating any money from selling food. Emily suggested using a borrowed projector – Will investigate for future event.
