The meeting began at 5:02 pm. Mr. Catlow provided opportunity for public comment. None offered.

Mr Catlow asked Mr. Cummings about preparing for the Town Meeting scheduled for 11/15/22. He asked the group what is best to present at the Town Meeting- requesting finding for total costs of a Public Safety Building or design costs only. There was discussion about the process of debt exclusion if funding for the total cost is requesting.

John Bennet reports that the MRI audit will be happening shortly and he expects that major deficits in PBS infrastructure will be noted.

lan asked if ARPA funds can be used for design costs and what the number is to trigger debt exclusion. Mr Soderberg suggests breaking out the cost of site prep and demolition, or delaying the vote in hopes of funding from the State.

Mr. Boudreau advised that a Public Safety funding bill has been bouncing around in Boston for years without any movement.

Outreach opportunities were discussed to provide information to town residents regarding the need for and status of the PSB. These include the Redemption 5k on 9/17, the tTouch a Truck on 10/1/22, Audobon Hey Day 9/24/22, the upcoming Town Buzz, and trunk or treat.



Meeting adjourned at 6:08pm.	








**SOUTH - FRONT ELEVATION**
