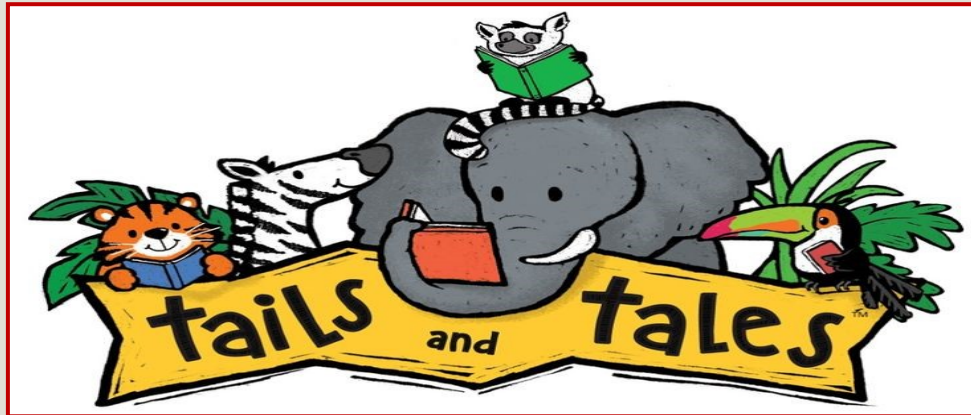


SUMMER READING PROGRAM
