## Virtual Training Guidelines of Attendee Participation

*RCAP Solutions offers virtual training using the GoToTraining Platform.*

*The following is a guideline for virtual attendees:*

### TROUBLES SIGNING IN?

- GoToTraining is designed to work with **Chrome or Firefox** so open a browser window
- Navigate to [www.gototraining.com](http://www.gototraining.com), click “Join (training)”. Enter the 9-Digit ID from your reminder email, and your email address
- You MAY need to click the “OK, I’m all set button” which hides at the bottom of the screen
  - Either hit the TAB button a couple times
- Respond to the reminder email to ask for help

### TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS:

- Log-in using your unique join link that is emailed to you (this is how you are recognized by the platform)
  - **Do not share this link or use someone else’s link**
- Device must have speakers (can use headphones if speakers do not work)
  - Only some classes require a microphone, you can always communicate by chat
  - Ask for assistance in the chat if you need to troubleshoot audio issues

If you are not familiar with the GoToTraining platform, sign on early so there is plenty of time for troubleshooting. Once in the session, Organizers can answer any questions.
