



## OBTAINING NOMINATION PAPERS

Town of Princeton residents can obtain nomination papers beginning **February 23, 2021**, by contacting the Princeton Town Clerk's office and making an appointment. With the new restrictions and difficulties arising from the Covid-19 pandemic, we have outlined some guidelines and suggestions below to help candidates navigate the collection of signatures. Please contact our office at any time if you have any questions.

### What can you do?

- **Multiple signature pages** - Each signee or family may have their own individual nomination form.
- **Candidates may mail or email individual nomination papers to people and ask them to print and sign them and return them.**
- **Candidates can set up a table, with permission, at a public place. Please include fresh pens, gloves, and sanitizer.**
- **Candidates may announce the locations of supporters who have covered porches and let people drop by to sign.**
- **Each page must have the candidate's information filled out on both the page's front and back.**

### What cant you do?

- **Electronic signatures** - All signatures must be in wet ink.
- **Time Extensions** - There are no extended deadlines currently approved by the Massachusetts State Legislature for the obtaining of nomination signatures.
- **Reduction of Signatures** - The number of signatures required remains the same.
