### Princeton COVID-19 Update

From Jan 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to Jan 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021 the Princeton BOH was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) of 6 additional Princeton residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive in Princeton as of 1/25 is now 100.
