## **COVID UPDATE AS OF January 13, 2022**

At their January 4, 2022, special meeting, the Princeton Selectboard voted unanimously to require all individuals over the age of 5 years old, regardless of vaccination status, to wear a mask or face covering in indoor public spaces effective immediately.
