PROPOSED MOTIONS

Article 1. Move to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$65,000 to pay debt service maturing in fiscal year 2023 for PFAS expenses.

Advisory Committee opinion to be determined after public hearing.

Article 2. Move to transfer the sum of \$125,000 from Free Cash for the design, engineering, and replacement of the water tank at the Thomas Prince School.

Advisory Committee opinion to be determined after public hearing.

Article 3. Move, pursuant to G.L. c. 40, §§ 15 and 15A, and all other applicable authority, to authorize the Select Board to convey to HF PROPCO, LLC, a Massachusetts limited liability company, an easement for the location, relocation, maintenance and use of a septic line under a portion of the public way located at 178 Westminster Road consisting of approximately 790.5 square feet, as shown on a plan entitled “Easement Plan 178 Westminster Road Princeton, Massachusetts” by Brennan Consulting dated August 8, 2022, a copy of which plan is on file with the Town Clerk, on such terms and for such consideration as the Select Board may determine.

Article 4. Move to accept the provisions of MGL Chapter 90 §17C, allowing the Select Board to establish a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on any roadway inside a thickly settled or business district other than a state highway.

Article 5. Move to accept the provisions of MGL Chapter 90, §18B, allowing the Select Board to establish designated safety zones which shall be posted as having a speed limit of 20 miles per hour.
