Princeton COVID-19 Update

From Jan 13th, 2021 to Jan 18th, 2021 the Princeton BOH was informed by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) of 8 additional Princeton residents with a confirmed positive test result for COVID-19. The number of residents who have tested positive in Princeton as of 1/18 is now 94.
