In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town who are qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Thomas Prince School in said Town, on Tuesday, the 18th day of November, 2014 at seven o'clock P.M. to act on the following articles of town affairs:

### **ARTICLE 1.**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for so-called "make ready" projects to prepare for the installation of a high speed internet system including, but not limited to, moving telephone and electrical lines, upgrading of utility poles, and constructing small structures for the housing of equipment, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies thereof fourteen days at least before time of said meeting at Bagg Hall, Mechanics Hall and the Princeton Post Office.
